MENORAH & TREE LIGHTING: A new menorah was installed at the Green this holiday season, with the help of generous donations from our Directors and the Middletown Parks Maintenance team who helped with assembly and installation. Rabbi Galperin from the Chabad Jewish Center of Holmdel performed a blessing and did the honors of lighting the menorah during our Menorah & Tree Lighting event on December 12th. Mayor Perry and Assemblyman Scharfenberger also attended the event to greet the crowd and help our village welcome the holiday season. Those in attendance were treated to delicious donuts, latkes and hot cider. Thank you to all who attended and helped make this event possible. We had a great turnout and everyone left full of good will and holiday cheer.

TRAFFIC & SAFETY COMMITTEE NEWS

LINCROFT ROAD IMPROVEMENTS: Since 1999, vehicle circulation on Rt 520/Newman Springs Road has been studied several times by Monmouth County. Improvements to Lincroft's downtown traffic issues and safety concerns were not implemented because the studies determined that a 2- way Acme Road was essential to any plan. This year, the Middletown Township Committee purchased a permanent roadway easement to expand the current one-way road. Monmouth County will be hiring an engineering firm to design the 2-way road with rear driveway access to the businesses. The LVGA has advocated for this since our formation, and we look forward to collaborating with Monmouth County on the project. Monmouth County has completed the design for a second roundabout at Brookdale College, located at the rear entrance to the college at Phalanx Road and Campus Drive. The utilities must be moved and final DEP permits must be received before the construction timeline can be finalized. With your donations, the LVGA paid roundabout expert Michael Wallwork to analyze the design and suggest changes to the plan for vehicle speed reduction and pedestrian comfort. New lighting, crosswalks, and a sidewalk to High Tech High School were added to the plan through our advocacy.

RIVER CENTRE REDEVELOPMENT AND HOUSING AT EXIT

109: In 2022, the Middletown Planning Board recommended that River Centre South at Exit 109 be designated as an area in need of redevelopment. To address the township's affordable housing obligations, Middletown amended the Housing Plan Element of their Master Plan to permit apartments at the site.
